Featuring all handmade sheet metal and an elaborate in-house girder fork, this Low Life-framed custom is owned by race car fabricator Jon Little. Jon does much of

the metal work for the Hanover, PA Independent Cycles East bike shop. This bike placed in the Radical Class this year at the Rat's Hole and won two other Daytona bike shows this spring. The small "handshift" lever isn't attached to the transmission, but actually controls a centerstand that keeps the bike upright when parked. It looks like a car part or two made it to the bike, with a '54 Chevy taillight massaged into the rear fender.
